Scholarship Application

There are scholarships through Club Zion that are available to qualifying students. The amount of scholarship money that is given to each student is determined by the cost of tuition, and the amount of financial aid and scholarship money he or she will be receiving from other sources. Each scholarship is renewable, providing the student continues to meet the scholarship requirements.

Club Zion Scholarships are more than just free money for college. We provide the spiritual and emotional support needed to get through college. In order to best support our students we maintain contact with them during their college education through visits, e-mails, and phone calls. Students are also required to submit their grades every quarter or semester to insure they are meeting the scholarship requirements.

In addition to maintaining a solid GPA and being involved in a church, scholarship students are required to complete an average of one hour of ministry service each week at the organization or church of their choice. Through the ministry service requirement, scholarship students will gain immeasurable experience and will learn things that cannot be taught in a classroom setting.

Scholarships and Guidelines

Requirements for a Club Zion Scholarship

You must:

- be dedicated to living a life for Christ
- have 2.5 high school GPA
- be admitted to/planning to attend, a 4-yr. college or university

If you qualify so far, you'll need to:

- fill out application
- submit an updated photo
- submit two letters of recommendation (one from a teacher and the other from a pastor or youth pastor)
- submit SAT or ACT scores (if not already in college)
- Submit high school transcript (if not already in college)

Once you are accepted into the program you'll need to:

- maintain a 2.5 GPA (submit your grades every quarter or semester)
- get involved in a church
- complete one hour of ministry service once a week at the organization or church of your choice
- keep in touch with Club Zion through emails, phone calls, and/or visits
